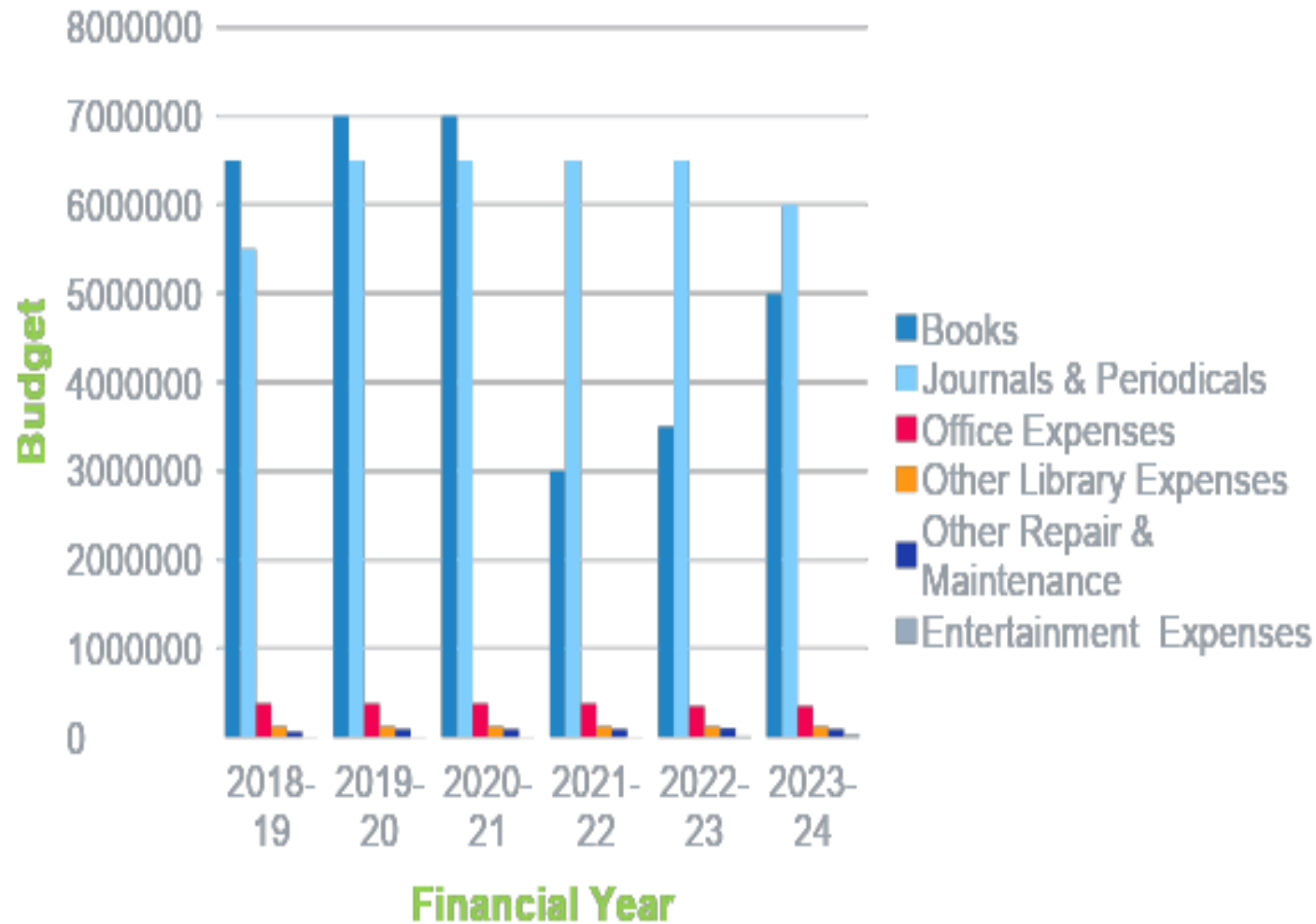

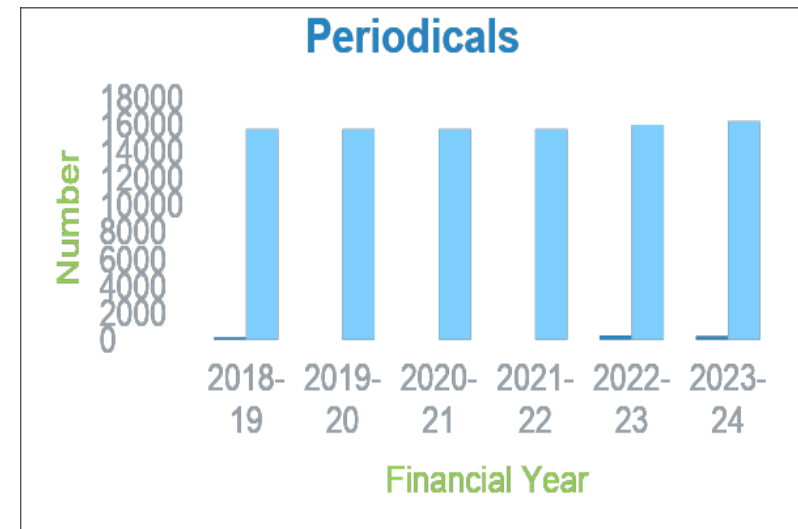
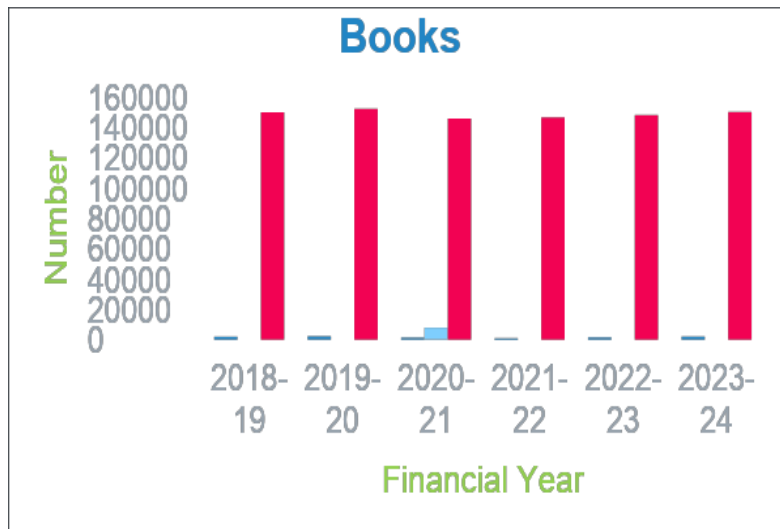

LIBRARY USAGE

- ▷ More 350 students visit Library every day.
- ▷ Most of the reading halls remain full.
- ▷ Active demand for extending library hours.
- ▷ 300-400 books issued & returned during peak hours.
- ▷ 50 Seater E-Resources Centre is heavily used.
- ▷ Plagiarism Checking Services-Most sought after-Nearly 15 cases attended each day.
- ▷ Scanning Services-quite popular.
- ▷ DELNET based Services- Lot of books borrowed from other Libraries
- ▷ Customised Info Services –Research Support- Provided regularly.
- ▷ Digital Library Services –In-house reference material used extensively in Political Science, Psychology, and Economics.

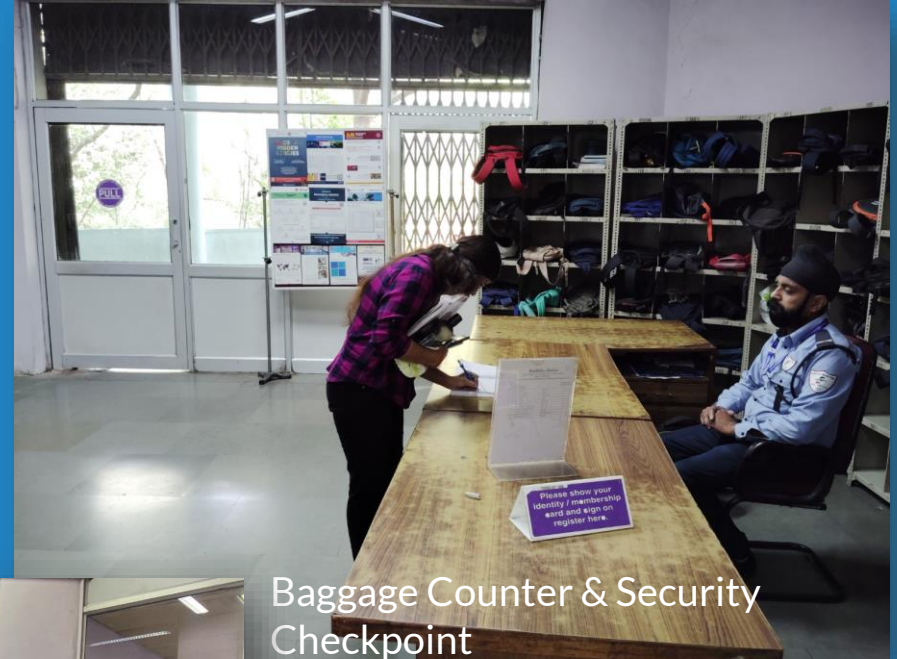
